Reciprocal Relationship

- Collaborative relationship protocols among NTC, SFU and NML
- Collaborative research agreements with member Nations
 - $\,\circ\,$ Seven Nations were in Co-creation phase
 - $\circ\,\,\textbf{Five}\,\,\textbf{Nations}\,\,\textbf{expressed}\,\,\textbf{desires}\,\,\textbf{or}\,\,\textbf{formally}\,\,\textbf{committed}$
- Data collection planned in five urban center for their citizens away from home
- Three pilot data collections conducted
- Blood samples sent to NML and tested
